<u>Candidates</u> who have applied earlier for admission to M. Tech. <u>Programs of IET</u>, <u>Lucknow but have not been allotted seat</u>, may appear afresh for this phase of counselling.

For appearing in counselling/written test, the candidates are required to deposit following two separate demand drafts at the time of reporting/registration as mentioned below.

- (i) Registration fee: Demand draft of Rs 1000/- (one thousand) non refundable.
- (ii) Seat confirmation fee: Demand draft of Rs. 50,000/- (Fifty thousand)

Demand drafts shall be in favour of "Director, I.E.T. Lucknow" payable at Lucknow. In case, candidate is not allotted any seat during counselling the same demand draft of Rs 50,000/- will be returned to the candidate. Fee is to be deposited only through Demand draft.

Allotment of seats:

Following the guidelines provided by AKTU regarding admission to M. Tech. courses, the allotment of seats in each program will be strictly based on the merit in following sequence:

- 1. First preference to GATE qualified candidates having Valid Gate score in respective discipline.
- 2. Second preference to UPSEE-2020 qualified candidates.
- 3. Third preference based on written test merit (qualifying marks 25% of Max Marks for GEN/OBC and 20% for SC/ST). Written test will be conducted only if the seat remains vacant after confirmation by valid GATE/UPSEE 2020 qualified candidates.

Documents required:

The candidates are required to bring the following documents in original and two set of self attested photocopies to be submitted at the time of reporting/registration.

- 1. Respective discipline Valid GATE score and admit card/ UPSEE-2020 rank card and admit card.
- 2. Qualifying exam mark sheet/certified internet copy of mark sheet, High school certificate, domicile & category certificate (if applicable). OBC certificate and EWS certificate must be issued after 1st April 2020.
- 3. Aadhar Card, Two recent photographs (passport size)
- 4.A DD of Rs 1000/- in favor of "Director, I.E.T. Lucknow" payable at Lucknow.
- 5.A DD of Rs. 50,000/- in favor of "Director, I.E.T. Lucknow" payable at Lucknow.
